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**General Biography**

Dr. Dorothy Riddle is a psychologist, a certified management consultant, and an economic development and social change specialist. She grew up in China and India and has worked in more than 85 countries. She began the first B.A.-granting women studies program at City University of New York and was a founding member of the Association for Women in Psychology. She was also responsible for some of the early work on homophobia, developing the Riddle Homophobia Scale (which is still in use) and conducting the first study of children of gay parents.

Her engagement in her community and the world focuses on building bridges of understanding among persons from different cultural, socioeconomic, and faith communities while working compassionately for justice and equity. She is the author of 15 books, the most recent of which are the *Enough for Us All* series – *Principles of Abundance for the Cosmic Citizen* (Vol. 1), *Positive Harmlessness in Practice* (Vol. 2), and the recently-released *Moving Beyond Duality* (Vol. 3).

Dr. Dorothy Riddle is a psychologist, social change specialist, and spiritual coach.
